Guidelines for Authors of the accepted papers

Final papers can be prepared and submitted following five easy steps:

Step 1 - Prepare Your Final Paper

- Paper must be written in English using the Microsoft Word templates for A4 format. Formatting may not be altered.
- **Number of pages: Minimum of 4 pages and Maximum of 6 pages** as required per paper in standard IEEE format.

Step 2 - Add Copyright information to the first page of the paper

- The appropriate copyright notice is to appear on the bottom of the first page of each paper according to the guidelines set forth for an IEEE Conference Publication. Insert below at the bottom of the first page of your final paper, the Copyright Notice as given below:

Step 3 - Check Your Final Paper

- All Camera Ready Paper (Final paper) should be submitted as IEEE Xplore compatible PDF file generated from IEEE PDF express site. IEEE PDF express is a free service to IEEE conferences, allowing their authors to make IEEE Xplore-compatible PDFs or to check PDFs that authors have made themselves for IEEE Xplore compatibility.
- Log in to the [IEEE PDF eXpress™](http://www.pdf-express.org) site at <http://www.pdf-express.org>
- Use PDF eXpress to verify the PDF file of the paper for IEEE-compliance before submission. *Papers that are not IEEE-compliant will not be included in the proceedings nor published.*

First-time Users of IEEE PDF eXpress:

1. Select the “New Users - Click Here” link.
2. Enter the following:
 - a. **47250X** for the Conference ID;
 - b. Your email address;
 - c. A password
3. Continue to enter information as prompted.
4. An online confirmation will be displayed and an email confirmation will be sent verifying your account setup.
5. For each conference paper, click “Create New Title”.
6. Enter identifying text for the paper (title is recommended but not required).
7. Click “Submit File for Checking or Converting”.
8. Browse and navigate to file, and click “Upload File”. You will receive an online confirmation and an email confirmation of successful upload.
9. Some minutes after, you will receive an email with your checked PDF or IEEE PDF eXpress™ converted PDF attached. If you submitted a PDF for checking, the email will show if your file passed or failed.
10. If passed, Log in and upload your IEEE Xplore-compatible PDF
11. If the PDF submitted fails the PDF check, do the following:
 - (a) Re-submit your source file for conversion by clicking Try again, then Submit Source Files for Conversion.
 - (b) Read the PDF Check report, then click "The PDF Check Report" in the sidebar to get information on possible solutions
 - (c) "Request Technical Help" Through your account
 - (d) Request a Manual Conversion through your account

Previous Users of IEEE PDF eXpress:

Previous users of IEEE PDF eXpress must follow the above steps, but should enter the same email and password that were used for previous conferences. Verify that your contact information is valid.

Note: When you click "Login", you'll receive an error saying you need to set up an account. Simply click "Continue". By entering your previously used email address and password combination, you will enable your old account for access to this new conference. You will receive online and email confirmation of successful account setup.

All the Camera Ready Copy (Final paper) shall be submitted as IEEE Xplore compatible PDF file generated from IEEE PDF express site. IEEE PDF express is a free service to IEEE conferences, allowing their authors to make IEEE Xplore-compatible PDFs (Conversion function) or to check PDFs that authors have made themselves for IEEE Xplore compatibility (PDF Check function).

Step 4 - Sign the Copyright Form for each paper

- Authors have to submit the e-Copyright Form (eCF) which will be sent by IEEE in the form of a link. Click the link and fill in the details of the copyright form, submit the form.
- Authors who do not submit the eCF, their paper will not be published in IEEE eXplore Digital Library.

Step 5 - Upload Your Final Paper

The final paper should be uploaded

Please double check the information that you provide during online submission:

- title of the paper
- name, affiliation, e-mail address of the authors
- name of the corresponding author
- complete mailing address, phone and e-mail address of the corresponding author
